

CHECKLIST FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS 2019

Please note: only Ojai Valley high school juniors and seniors and college students are eligible for 2019

Create a login for your application through *EntryThingy*

You will be asked for your address/phone/email etc.

Please fill out all information so we can contact you

1. DESCRIPTION OF WORK: write 2D, 3D
2. STATEMENT SPECIFIC TO ENTRY: paste your personal statement (not to exceed one page) that includes art experience, educational goals, and other pertinent information about your work, yourself, and your vision for the future (**Note: If you applied previously, you can update your statement by clicking on MY PROFILE and then click EDIT PROFILE**)
3. Your age
4. High School or College you attend
5. Grade level: Write junior, senior, etc.
6. Check box that says: "entry's file may be used for publicity"
7. Click the ADD FILE box
 - a. Title of your piece
 - b. Add one sentence description of work
 - c. Dimensions: for 2D/3D work (including installations) H" x W" x D" as applicable
 - d. Materials
 - e. Year work completed
8. Upload your image: click CHOOSE FILE, UPLOAD
(*Good photography is important, feature the work (nothing extraneous) and consider focus, color, contrast, etc.*)
 - a. Make sure each file entry is no greater than 1MB in jpeg format. Example: if using a smart phone camera, choose "large photo" option. If you have problems, talk to a teacher, another artist, or knowledgeable friend.
 - b. After your file is uploaded, you will see your image and entered information. Keep adding files until you have submitted images of five (5) different works. Up to 3 additional images per piece MAY be submitted to show detail or additional views.
 - c. When done, hit the SUBMIT ENTRY button. By submitting, you verify that the work is yours.

You are now done with the online entry; continue with TEACHER RECOMMENDATION process.

Teachers are to fill out the online form and submit electronically. We

prefer both recommendations be from art teachers, but in the case of high school students or special situations, one of these may be from an instructor in another subject.

All application materials must be received by **May 10, 2019 at 5:00PM.**

PLEASE NOTE: Scholarship winners will be required to 1) deliver work on June 1, 9-10:00AM, 2) attend award reception on June 8th, 4-6:00PM, 3) pick up their work on August 31, 9-10:00AM.

Work must be ready to hang; no saw tooth hangars.

Students who do not follow the exhibition and reception requirements will not receive scholarships.
